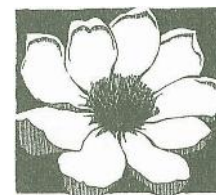

Who We Are

Since its creation in 1991, the Magnolia Woods Civic Association (MWCA) has served as steward of the neighborhood. The elected Board of Directors represents the area on matters related to safety, zoning and code enforcement, and strives to maintain a high quality of life for residents and visitors. The association:

- Works with city agencies, the Baton Rouge Police Department, the District 12 Metro Council representative, and other officials;
- Fosters communications and a sense of community among residents;
- Sponsors special projects aimed at preserving and enhancing the natural beauty of our neighborhood;
- Coordinates with other neighborhood organizations to address issues of importance to our area; and
- Is recognized by city and community organizations as the consensus “voice” for Magnolia Woods.

What We Do

- The MWCA has conducted an annual reforestation project since 2012 to replace trees lost to storms, age and disease. Roughly 50 native storm-resistant trees were distributed to residents in Spring 2016 alone.
- Twice each year, the MWCA organizes a Trash Bash to remove litter along streets and in common areas. Volunteers gather at the Magnolia Woods Pool parking lot for coffee and donuts before hitting the street.
- The association sponsors “Fire Ant Funerals” each year to reduce fire ant infestations at no cost to residents and without harming the environment. Widespread participation is essential to the success of this all-volunteer project.
- The annual Magnolia Woods Neighborhood Halloween party is a family-friendly gathering that offers safe fun for children and a great way for adults to get together.
- A neighborhood Christmas party is held in conjunction with the MWCA Annual Membership Meeting.
- The association sponsors and publicizes an annual Neighborhood Garage Sale.
- MWCA volunteers are helping Magnolia Woods Elementary develop a Learning Garden for the benefit of students and neighborhood families alike.
- Citizens on Patrol, a free, volunteer effort sponsored by the MWCA lets would-be burglars and vandals know “the eyes of Magnolia Woods are upon you!”
